Q16. Along which roads in particular do you envisage a problem and why?

- Most popular responses for the roads identified were:
 - Barton Road
 - Pokeriage Corner
 - Fishwick Corner
- Most popular answers for why there was a problem at these locations were:
 - Speeding
 - Parking
 - Poor Visibility
 - Overgrown Vegetation

Q18. What improvements should be considered to improve safety in the parish for people with disabilities?

- Most popular responses for improvements were:
 - More dropped kerbs and levelled footpaths
 - Properly maintained hedges along footpaths
 - Repaired footpaths / fewer potholes
 - Pedestrian crossings especially at / close to services and facilities
 - Tunnel / better access at the station to prevent risk to the blind and hard of hearing and wheelchair users
 - More paved footpaths for motorised wheelchairs on main roads
 - Better lighting for all particularly near / close to facilities / services
 - Wider footpaths to allow for cyclists, pedestrians and those using mobility scooters.
 - Enforcement of no parking on footpaths / pavements.
 - Improvements need under railway bridge to allow disabled access
 - Blue Badge parking spaces at facilities / services in the Village
 - 20mph limit near post office and around the schools.

Q19. What projects should be considered to improve highways and transport in the parish?

- Most popular responses for improvements were:
 - Repairing of potholes
 - Improve road maintenance

 - Increase lighting along roads
 - Impose the speed limits
 - Further traffic calming
 - Improve / create cycle paths
