## CIL SPENDING REVIEW – February 2022 for the year ending 31<sup>st</sup> March 2022

### Applications for CIL Funding – prior notification of bids submitted

#### 1. CIL Funding

The Parish Council has a duty to spend CIL income on:

- providing, improving, replacing, operating or maintaining infrastructure that supports the development of the parish council area or
- anything else concerned with addressing the demands that development places on the area.

Providing CIL is spent in accordance with the above CIL monies may be used to provide seed or match funding with other income streams and / or may be spent collaboratively with other parish councils, community interest companies or other providers to make the most efficient use of funding to benefit the community.

#### 2. Processing of CIL Bids Submitted:

The application process will be centred upon a bidding round with consideration on a twice-yearly basis, with submission (preferably by email) of bids by applicants using the form below. The twice-yearly bid round cycle is as follows:

Bid Round 1 for the year	<p>By 31<sup>st</sup> May - Applications for CIL to be submitted</p> <p>By 30<sup>th</sup> June - Bids to be validated and assessed against policy criteria</p> <p>July - Bids to be considered by full Council at Parish Council Meeting</p> <p>August - Letters to be issued confirming outcome of bids to applicants</p>
Bid Round 2 for the year	<p>By 31<sup>st</sup> December - Applications for CIL to be submitted</p> <p>By 31<sup>st</sup> January (year following) - Bids to be validated and assessed against policy criteria</p> <p>February - Bids to be considered by full Council at Parish Council Meeting</p> <p>March - Letters to be issued confirming outcome of bids to applicants</p>
