- Network Rail – MSDC have been asked for an update which has been sent on. Network Rail seem to be saying we do not need these.
- Ixworth Road; still no definitive response. I have sent highways the photos of all the mud and state of the path and road here. There have been numerous emails about the state of the road and lack of work .
- Sewerage/Manhole Cover issues Mill Lane- this is the responsibility of AWA , but environmental health should be part of the action.
- Norton Road Parking Restrictions - I have agreed this to include junction with Wren close as there is a particular problem there. The legal process will now begin then if no objections can be implemented
- A14 - I organised a TEAMS meeting with Beyton, SCC highways and Highways England. The problems in Beyton have escalated with extra traffic and thus speeding. I know this is also a problem for Thurston, so I asked that all efforts, including extra signage be used for Thurston as well. Beyton Clerk took notes which I will pass onto you.

**Appendix D - District Cllr’s Report to Full Council – Cllrs. Austin Davies and David Bradbury**

- Election campaigning took up the majority of time during April. Minimal contact between Officers and Councillors.
- MSDC Meeting – First of this administration will be on the 22<sup>nd</sup> May.
- Mid Suffolk District Council welcomed the newly elected Councillors.
- Gateway 14 – Building of the ‘Range’ warehouse is progressing on schedule with the metal framework starting to be erected. MSDC is considering submitted plans for a second warehouse.
- Planning –
  - DC/19/02090 Gladman have taken this case to a public appeal. Submitted a written argument to the planning inspector. The hearing is set for July. Advice was sort in relation to Suffolk House, Norton.
  - Enforcement officers took the MSDC case on ‘The Field of Dreams’ to court and reached agreement on both the fines and corrective actions.
  - Persimmon development (Ixworth Road, Thurston) - Held a site meeting with Site Manager to discuss their solutions to an overflowing sewerage manhole, Ixworth Road kerb line and their landscaping/bird box plans.
