## SUFFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (PARISH OF THURSTON) (C559 NORTON ROAD, U4917 PAKENHAM ROAD, AND U4908 CHURCH ROAD) (30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2021

Suffolk County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 84(1) and (2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:

- 1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30mph in any direction on the length of roads specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
- No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
- This Order may be cited as the Suffolk County Council (Parish of Thurston) (C559 Norton Road, U4917 Pakenham Road, and U4908 Church Road) (30 Mph Speed Limit) Order 2021 and shall come into operation on 4 June 2021.

## SCHEDULE 1

## 30mph Speed Limit Parish of Thurston

ROAD	DESCRIPTION
Norton Road (C559)	From a point 100 metres east of its junction with the U4920 Sandpit Lane to a point 226 metres east of the centre of its junction with the U4908 Church Road.
Church Road (U4908)	From a point 263 metres north of its junction with the U4918 School Road, to its junction with the C559 Norton Road.
Pakenham Road (U4917)	From its junction with the C559 Norton Road for 30 metres in a northerly direction.
