CIL SPENDING REVIEW – NOVEMBER 2020

Update to Paper submitted to full Council – 04.11.20

Neighbourhood CIL is governed by the CIL Regulations and the rate at which it is paid is set out in national legislation. For those Parish Councils with a made Neighbourhood Plan it is 25% (with no CAP) and for Parishes where is no made Neighbourhood Plan it is 15% subject to a cap which is set out nationally (in legislation) - see below:-
