- 1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 mph in any direction on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.

3. This Order may be cited as the Suffolk County Council (Parish of Thurston) (C692 Thurston/Mount Road and C693 Thurston/New Road) (40 mph Speed Limit) Order 201- and shall come into operation on 18 December 2019.
