To resolve that under the Public Bodies (Admission to Meetings) Act 1960, the public be excluded from the meeting on the grounds that the meeting has been called to consider an appeal a decision taken by the Sub-Committee of the Policy and Resources Committee on behalf of the Parish Council and that under the Data Protection Act 1998, a council has obligations as to how it uses personal data about the individual complainant and those named in the complaint.	
4.	Members to hear the case for an appeal against the decision taken by the Policy and Resources Sub-Committee on Friday 13 <sup>th</sup> March 2020 with reference to the Council's complaint procedure: a) To consider the grounds of appeal as submitted in writing by the complainant b) To carry out a review of the procedures that were followed – <i>to note that this is not a review of the decision given</i> c) Members to ask questions of the clerk if appropriate	
5.	Members to consider whether or not the grounds for the appeal have been made	
6.	Members to convey to the Clerk and the complainant the Council's decision which will be final. Depending on the matter under dispute, there may be grounds for referral to the local government Ombudsman, but generally the ombudsman does not cover the work of Parish Councils.
